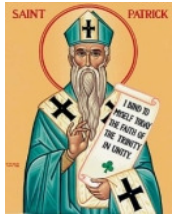

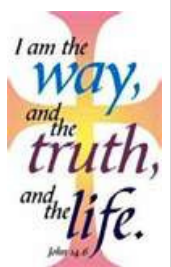

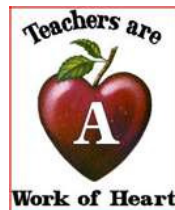
### Dear Ku-ring-gai Chase Parish Community
