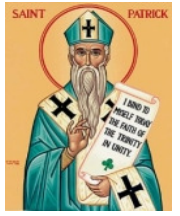

SOCIAL JUSTICE COMMENT - ABORIGINAL AND TORRES STRAIT ISLANDER SUNDAY



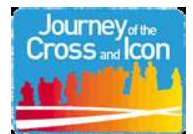
The Catholic Church has officially designated the first Sunday in July as Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander Sunday thus encouraging Catholics locally to focus their worship on Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people and their culture and the issues of social justice they represent. In the first week in July Australians throughout the country celebrate together the survival of Aboriginal peoples, the continuation of Aboriginal culture and the contribution that Indigenous Australian make to the nation.
