



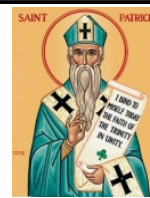

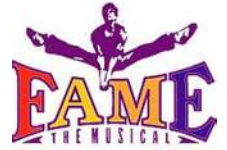

SOCIAL JUSTICE COMMENT

July 11 - World Population Day. In early 2006, the world population reached 6.5 billion with half being under the age of 25 and in 57 developing countries, over 40% of the population is under 15. In 2000 it was estimated that 238 million (22.5%) of the world's total youth population survived on less than \$1 a day. Interesting statistics.

NAIDOC week 1-7 July. NAIDOC was developed during the late 1950's as a way for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples to bring issues that concerned them to the attention of governments and the general public. It celebrates the uniqueness of indigenous traditions and culture and is a recognition of the ongoing struggle for justice and equality for indigenous people.
