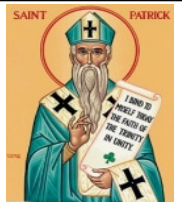

**POPE BENEDICT'S WORLD PEACE DAY MESSAGE** - The Vatican announced today that *The human family, a community of peace* is the theme of Benedict XVI's message for the 41st World Peace Day which will be celebrated on 1 January. In his address the Holy Father says that whoever, "even unknowingly," goes against the family "based on marriage between a man and a woman" undermines peace because the family is the "primary agency of peace" on earth. He goes further noting that this earth of ours is the "common house" for the "family of peoples" who are tasked with preserving it, pursuing a path of dialogue at a time of concern over a looming arms race.



In his message the Pope starts from the premise that "in a healthy family life we experience some of the fundamental elements of peace" like justice, love, mutual aid and openness to others. The family thus enables its members to experience and teach peace. Hence hostility to the family means undermining the peace. For this reason we must be inspired by its values whether at the community, national and international levels.
