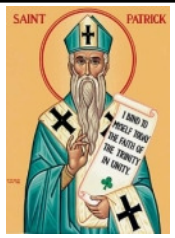

MESSAGE FOR THE WORLD DAY OF PEACE

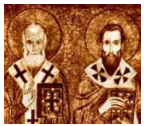
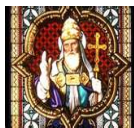
VATICAN CITY - Below follow some extracts from Benedict XVI's message for the celebration of the XLII World Day of Peace (1 January 2009) on the theme "Fighting Poverty to Build Peace."

"Fighting poverty requires attentive consideration of the complex phenomenon of globalization. ... The reference to globalization should also alert us to the spiritual and moral implications of the question, urging us, in our dealings with the poor, to set out from the clear recognition that we all share in a single divine plan: we are called to form one family in which all - individuals, peoples and nations - model their behaviour according to the principles of fraternity and responsibility".....

"Almost half of those living in absolute poverty today are children. ... When the family is weakened, it is inevitably children who suffer. If the dignity of women and mothers is not protected, it is the children who are affected most"..... "Effective means to redress the marginalization of the world's poor through globalization will only be found if people everywhere feel personally outraged by the injustices in the world and by the concomitant violations of human rights".

"In regard to the Church, her cooperation will never be wanting, be the time or the occasion what it may". ...
