

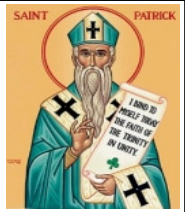

SACRAMENTAL PROGRAMME: CONFIRMATION



The Sacrament of Confirmation will be celebrated on Friday 26 September by Bishop David Walker DD, at 6pm at St Bernard's and 7.30pm at St Patrick's. An information page and enrolment form can be obtained from the back of the church. Children must be baptised and aged seven or over and should receive

Confirmation before First Holy Communion. Details of the full Sacramental Program are also on a sheet at the back of the Church.

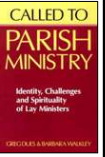

CAR PARK—UNITING CHURCH ASQUITH
