

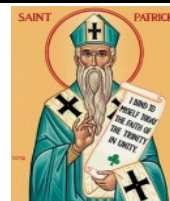

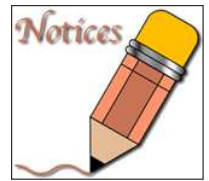

Climate Change This topic was discussed at the United Nations during the Pope's recent visit and these comments made were: Without immediate action, climate change will have a disastrous impact on the world's poorest people and undo the gains in poverty reduction, nutrition, health and education. 2.6 billion people living on less than \$2 daily contribute least to global emissions, but pay for the actions of others. What Can We Do? To limit global warming to under 2°C will call for more global cooperation than we have ever seen before. Mitigation works to slow climate change by lowering levels of greenhouse gases in the atmosphere. More trees will absorb carbon dioxide from the air and store it in the soil or in their trunks and roots. Adaptation works to reduce danger to people and places by building seawalls, relocating to higher ground to protect communities from more flooding.

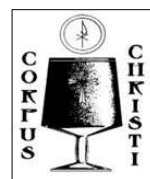

FROM OUR SCHOOLS:

Volunteers (expressions of interest) are needed at St Bernard's School and St Patrick's School: The WYD organising body has asked Parish Priests and School Principals to muster volunteers to assist Pilgrims coming to their schools for WYD Week commencing Sunday 6 July until Saturday 12 July. There are effectively 6 night time shifts over the six days, and 2 people are needed on each shift ... therefore 12 volunteers are needed in each school (NB Shift time: 7pm-9am). It might be better to have a shift from 7pm-6am and then have a short shift from 6am-9am ... These details can, of course, be finalised later.



Re the two people per shift: one must be a School /Parish community member who knows the lay out of the school well, and the other can be anyone 16 years or over. Volunteers will only be fulfilling a role of assisting the Official WYD Adult Pilgrim Leaders in the case of emergency; they will not be required to supervise young Pilgrims. Please consider volunteering for this important cause and inform either School Office or the Pastoral Centre if you can assist ... Thank you.

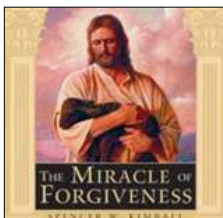
