

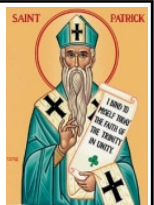

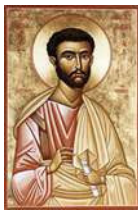

## SOCIAL JUSTICE COMMENT



The **National Climate Emergency Rally**, which takes place on Saturday 13 June in capital cities across the country and in Wollongong, will call upon the government to foster a rapid transition to 100% renewable energy, and to exercise strong leadership in the international climate negotiations. In Sydney, people from a diversity of faiths will walk together from Barangaroo, through the Rocks and Circular Quay. **Parish WYD11 Internship Program** An internship programme will commence in our Diocese on 2 August 2009, in conjunction with WYD11. Applicants must be between 16 and 33 by July 2009 and commit to 5 hours service per week in any area of Parish ministry within the Parish for the next 2 years (400 hours). The successful interns would have their airfare and registration funded by the Diocese. Broken Bay Youth Ministry will be hosting four information sessions for Parish leaders, interested candidates and parents. Any person interested in the Broken Bay Parish Internship program should attend at least one information session. Attendance at the session does not mean that a person has to commit to the program.
