We travel through the lush fertile vineyards until we arrive at McGuigans Vineyard located in the heart of the Hunter Valley. Here we will be guided through a tasting of McGuigan wines from the popular Black Label to exclusive labels such as Vineyard Select and their Personal Reserve. We also visit the Hunter Valley Cheese Company where we can try and if we want buy cheese/s. In the heart of Pokolbin, within easy access to wineries. we have lunch at the Cellar Restaurant (Main, Dessert, Tea/Coffee), followed by a glass of house wine (quite a choice). On our way home we call in at the Hunter Valley Olive & Gourmet Food Centre, which is one of the largest specialty food outlets in the Valley and here if you wish you can purchase from a huge range of jams, preserves, oil dippers, chutneys, dukkah, herbs and spices, etc. The Olive Centre was launched in 2003 to integrate a love for food and wine. 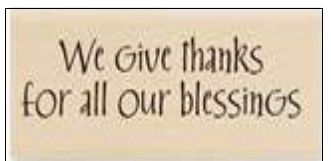

GOING TO HOSPITAL? Parishioners who wish to receive Holy Communion while in hospital, are advised that you need to make this known when being admitted. Arrangements for the celebration of the Anointing of the Sick should be made before hospital with one of the priests in the Parish, by contacting the Pastoral Centre. In cases of emergency, Hornsby Hospital, Sydney Adventist Hospital and Neringah have a Pager system to call a priest 24 hours a day.

PIETY STALL Our Parish piety stall is run by the St Vincent de Paul Society and sells religious gifts and mementos for Christenings, First Holy Communions and Confirmations. It also stocks cards and invitations for these occasions as well as new baby, birthday, Reconciliation, thank you, sympathy, Easter, Christmas and anniversary cards; missals and bibles, catechisms, some prayer books, rosary beads, crucifixes, holy medals and holy cards, Christmas decorations and gifts, and Advent and Columban calendars. For younger children there are religious colouring in books and board books. In addition there is a small range of Christian inspirational items such as bookmarks, plaques, magnets and mugs. The piety stall is located on the back wall of St Bernard's church, Berowra Heights. It is open after the 5.30pm and 9am Masses each weekend. If you are after something in particular which is not in stock, we will try to source and order it for you. CANONISATION OF BLESSED MARY MACKILLOP

The following information has been forwarded from the Australian Catholic Bishops Conference: The Canonisation of Blessed Mary MacKillop will be seen live both on Australian TV and the Web, direct from St Peter's Square in Rome. Sky TV will broadcast live from about 6.30pm (Eastern Time) on Sunday night, October 17, while ABC News 24, the new 24 hour free-to-air station for the National Broadcaster, has also indicated it will

broadcast as much as possible of the Canonisation ceremony. Both will provide expert commentary on the events as they unfold. ABC 1's Compass program will feature a Canonisation special at 10pm. Other stations have indicated they will have features and live crosses to Rome as well as updates in their regular news services.

A live web stream of the ceremony will also be available, complete with commentary. Through the Internet people can access the web stream from the websites listed below.

TV: ABC1 At 7pm: ABC News will cross live to the Vatican for the latest coverage on the canonisation celebration. Please note: we do not know if this will be coverage of the Mass only, or will include commentary and other footage.

TV: ABC NEWS 24 From 6pm: a two-hour news special broadcast live from the Vatican. Will include live crosses to Rome as well as to reporters around Australia where people will gather to join in the celebrations. These sites include: St Mary's Cathedral, Sydney; Mary MacKillop Chapel, North Sydney; significant sites in Penola, South Australia; the Exhibition Centre, Melbourne; and St Francis Xavier's Cathedral, Adelaide.
