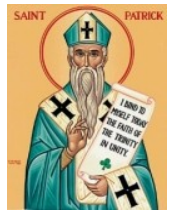

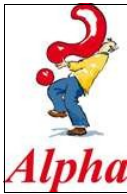
### Pope's Encyclical, *Charity in Truth*
