

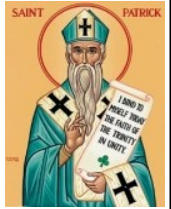

SOCIAL JUSTICE COMMENT



Today is **Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander Sunday** with the theme 'Justice and Peace for All'. We are encouraged to focus our worship on Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders and their culture and the issues of social justice they represent. The focus is on youth and communities to allow for Peace and Justice for all while promoting and celebrating the cultural identity of our peoples across the nation. During National Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Sunday we acknowledge their deeply religious and spiritual traditions with respect. This is followed by National Aboriginal and Islander Week which aims to promote the rich Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander heritage to all people on a regional, national and international level. It is also a celebration of the uniqueness of indigenous traditions and cultures and recognition of the ongoing

struggle for justice and equality for indigenous people.

Amnesty Petition – "Put People Before Politics". Amnesty is running an on-line petition directed at local MPs calling for an end to the Government's freeze on the processing of Sri Lankan and Afghan asylum claims and for an end to 'an ugly game of politics with utter disregard to the cost of human suffering.' The message of the petition is: 'this is not how we treat vulnerable people in Australia. And as your constituents, we will not stand for it.' 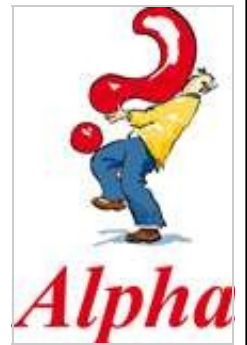


THANK YOU to Sue Watts for preparing the Prayers of Intercession and Welcomes for the month of June.

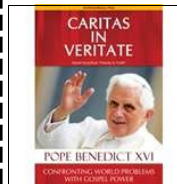
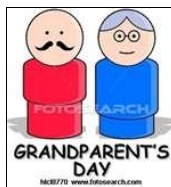


FROM OUR SCHOOLS
